The message can be changed by editing the label with id 'aw.DropdownList.moreOptions'.  - Feature: DropdownList: The list of options will now automatically load more options as the user scrolls. This behavior works out of the box for all data sources. However, if the data source is a catalog and the catalog provides a filter variable, but no start variable, it will fall back to showing a 'more options' message at the end of the list after loading a certain limited amount of options. In other words, to make use of the continuous loading, a catalog must either support all (filter, start and limit) variables, or none at all.  - BugFix: DropdownList: When executing a search on the server side, the version filter as well as the language of the rendered screen are now passed to the server as well.
