DataTable	Medium	A new source type "Data Class" has been added to the Data Table screen component. It will eventually replace the source type "Custom Model". The custom model is now marked as deprecated. The custom model doesn't persist local data class properties between two screen rendering phases. The new source type has been implemented to remedy this limitation.
		It works the same as the custom model, but instead of providing an instance of the model, you have to select the corresponding data class that shall be used. The whole instance lifecycle will then be handled by Appway, making sure it lives longer than for one page request only. To access the model, use the new function "DataTableModel()" with the id bound to the new property "Model Id Binding".
		The new source type has some more advantages: 1. It is now possible to provide a description that defines the possibilities of the model. For instance it is possible to define each sortable and/or filterable column that can be used in the screen editor. Furthermore for each filter it is possible to define which operations and precisions can be handled by the model. Together with a string reference for each column/sorter/filter, the developer of the data class model has full control over the possibilities provided to the screen developer. 2. It is now possible to declare whether the a model is "steady" or "not steady" using the method "setSteady(boolean)" of the DataTableDescription. A table is steady if the content does not have to be cleared with every fetch request (default). This means if the user scrolls or changes a page, and then returns to the previous scroll position or page, no new fetch request is made. Instead the previously loaded rows will be displayed. If the table is not steady, the content of the browser will always be cleared, and thus re-fetched.
DataTable	Low	It is now possible to define actions for two new events on a data table: "onready" is triggered when the table has loaded its data for the first time. "oncount" is triggered when the visible row count or the total row count of the table has changed.
Workspace	Low	[EXPERIMENTAL] The configuration property "nm.workspace.cache.version.enabled" may be used to force a browser to refetch cached workspace resources after an upgrade to a newer Appway version. If it is set to "true" (default is "false"), URLs in " <script>" and "link>" elements in the HTML head section get a query string parameter "awv" with the current Appway version number as value. For development versions (ending with "-dev"), the startup timestamp is appended. Example URL: "/js/workspace.js?awv=6.2.2".</td></tr></tbody></table></script>
