Area	Importance	Description
Shutdown	Low	Background activities of the process engine like process threads and the process job scheduler are now stopped very early during the shutdown procedure. If a process thread is currently executing a process job, Appway waits for a maximum of 20 seconds before continuing with the shutdown procedure. If the thread has not stopped in this time span, an error message is written to the log files: "Process Thread has not stopped: <threadinfo>".</threadinfo>

Bugfix

Area	Importance	Description
Data Table	Low	When changing a page, the table now resizes to ensure that the layout of open interlines is restored. This was an issue when using an adaptive flow layout in an interline.
Refactoring	Low	Refactoring a Data Class ID was not reflected correctly in inline variable declarations such as "ForEach Data \$d In \$ds Do".
Refactoring	Low	Refactoring a Data Class ID was not reflected correctly in scripts on indexed collection instantiation types such as "Indexed Data \$d := new Indexed Data;".
Shutdown	Low	Process engine threads are no longer interrupted during shutdown. If a thread is executing a process job at shutdown, job execution completes normally before the thread exits. Interrupting the thread has led to unexpected side-effects with exceptions like ClosedByInterruptException during I/O operations or IllegalMonitorStateException when accessing the business object repository. As a result, there have been empty or corrupt files or suspended process instances.
Workspace Library Builder	Low	The builder now ignores CSS properties with a URL that contains a data string (e.g. Base64). These values are no longer prepended with an absolute path.
